Meeting Minutes – February 2, 2010

ATTENDED: Stephen Herr, Mark Sanzone, Jay McAlonen, Sandra Catlin, Molly Oliver

January 5th minutes were approved as written.

GM Herr reported that \$1900 was approved by the BOD for crosswalk repainting at "Starbucks" corner.

The proposal for portable ice warning signs was discussed and declined. Too many issues with timely placement and removal, potential liability for not having them at needed locations, in addition to the cost.

GM Herr reported that NRNA (of which FHHA is a member) is engaged with TriMet looking at new bus routes for our area. We will stay involved with the effort. The hope is that one day we may be able to subsidize TriMet and eliminate our private shuttle.

GM Herr reported on the investigation of bus passes for the shuttle. The best option is a special sticker that destructs if peeled away and can be purchased for less than 50 cents each. There are many complexities with implementing such a plan and we will not unless there is significant pressure from the community.

Two Brothers Painting and a Sherman Williams rep met with Mark Sanzone and GM Herr to propose a trial painting of a street pole. The proposal was forwarded to PDOT and a meeting is now scheduled for 2/23 at 9am to further discuss.

The SST survey is up on Survey Monkey and the link has been sent out via email. (Please take the survey if you have not already.)

We reviewed the speeding complaints from residents on Bartholomew. Mark Sanzone will reply to them.

Complaints of late night basketball and noise by teens at the city park (next to FP school) were discussed. There is not much we can do as it is a city park and they are there during open hours (closes at midnight per the sign). Mark Sanzone will reply to them as GM Herr already has.

Jay McAlonen reported on the police action for traffic issues. Portland PD was out 3 days in January and issued an estimated 80 tickets for speeding and running stop signs. Jay will follow up with contacts regarding getting the speed reader board trailer out, and Mark will contact Officer Abrahamson about the portable pole mounted versions.

The BOD meets on 2/9. Mark Sanzone plans to attend.
